Cycling Information

IBikeLondon have created two loops (3.5k and 10k) for Car Free Day. http://www.ibikelondon.com

Short Self-guided loop - approx. 3.5k

- The route has been created for cyclists of all ages and abilities to enjoy a traffic-free, fun and relaxed ride.
- Riders can join anywhere, however, we recommend beginning at the start point marked on Fair Street.
- The route travels anti-clockwise across Tower Bridge, around Tower Hill, along Upper and Lower Thames Street, around Fish Lane, back across London Bridge and along Tooley Street.
- This route comprises barriered cycle lanes and a section of the cycle superhighway with directional signage.

Extended iBike London guided loop: Approx. 10k:

This is a guided ride which will be accompanied by a fleet of music bikes pumping out tunes organised by IBikeLondon. The pace will be relaxed and suitable for families and cyclists of all abilities.

- Start point: Fair Street, SE1 2XT
- Finish point: Fair Street, SE1 2XT
- This is an extended route which will last approximately 1.5 hours. Riders will complete the 3.5k loop and then continues along the River Thames before returning and finishing at Fair Street.

- Ride 1: depart 10:30am
- Ride 2: depart 1:00pm
- Ride 3: depart 3:30pm
