27 June 2019

The London CONTEST Board meeting of 27 June 2019 was chaired by the Deputy Mayor for Policing and Crime. The Board is made up of members from MOPAC, MPS, Home Office, NHS England, City of London, National Probation Service (NPS), TfL, DfE, and London Councils.

Agenda Item 1: Actions. The outstanding matters were addressed.

Agenda Item 2: Pursue. The Board was provided with a current threat briefing and additional information on recent terror related court cases.

Agenda Item 3: The Board heard updates from the DfE on improving safeguarding for children not in school.

Agenda Item 4: Protect. There was a discussion on protective security.

Agenda Item 5: The Board heard updates from the MPS on business engagement

Agenda Item 6: Prevent. The Board heard an update from the London Prevent Board, including work on the Multi Agency Centre (MAC) pilot

Agenda Item 7: The Board heard and discussed an update from the Mayor's Countering Violent Extremism programme.

Agenda Item 8: Prepare. The Board received updates on the work of the London Resilience Group and London's preparedness.
