

London's exports

How much and what does London export?

London's share of total UK exports in 2015

46%

Services

£100.4bn of services

Total London exports for goods and services

£131.1bn in 2015

up from £126.4bn in 2011

Miscellaneous manufactured articles (including, for example, clothing, toys and games, works of art and antiques) was the largest goods export product by value (**£11.9bn** in 2015)

Financial services remained the largest service export sector in 2015, with exports worth around **£28.3bn**, down from £30.7bn in 2011

Where does London export to?

The EU has been London's (and the UK's) number one destination for goods exports, accounting for **£12.5bn** in 2015

However, broken down by specific country yields the following top 5:

1. USA

2. Germany

3. France

4. Holland

5. Hong Kong

For services, the EU is London's (and the UK's) main trading partner, accounting for **£15.6bn** of service exports in 2015 (this figure does not include financial services among other sectors)
