Regeneration Committee – 16 September 2014

The London Assembly's Regeneration Committee held a meeting on 16 September 2014 to discuss stadium-led regeneration.

During the course of the discussion the Committee suggested that the Chairman write to the GLA Planning Team, in relation to a Mayoral Development Corporation (MDC), to follow up on issues around local employment targets.

- What employment targets does the GLA expect to set under a new MDC at Old Oak Common?
 - Would you expect to set a London-wide or a local employment target?
 - What proportion of employees would you aim to be residents of the three boroughs of Hammersmith and Fulham, Brent, and Ealing?
- Does the GLA have a strategy to ensure local jobs for local people at Old Oak Common?
- What structures would you use to establish and manage local employment targets; for example, would you make local employment targets a requirement of all large contracts?

I would be grateful to receive any of the above information by mid-October, if possible, in order for it to be reported back to the Committee.
