Regeneration Committee – 16 September 2014

I would like to thank you on behalf of the London Assembly's Regeneration Committee for attending our meeting on 16 September 2014 to discuss stadium-led regeneration. We found it very helpful to have a range of views and expertise represented at the meeting.

During the course of the discussion you agreed to provide figures relating to numbers of local employees at the Olympic Park; including those employed in construction and operational roles, and those in apprenticeship programmes. The Committee also had further follow-up questions in relation to the discussion:

- How many employees at the Olympic Park are residents of the Growth Boroughs? (Please provide a breakdown for employees in both construction and non-construction roles)
- What key lessons has the LLDC – working with the Growth Boroughs – learnt about the most effective ways to ensure local communities are able to access the job opportunities on the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park?
- Please describe the process the E20 Stadium Partnership has used to develop the contract for the future operator of the Olympic Stadium.
- Will the operator's contract be a management contract, or will it be a framework within which the operator has some discretion over how the Stadium runs and the events it is used for?
- Who will hold the Stadium operator to account for its performance? Please describe the accountability arrangements in place for monitoring the operator's contract.

I would be grateful to receive any of the above information by mid-October, if possible, in order for it to be reported back to the Committee.
