## 1 Justice Matters: March Meeting

There was a discussion planning the March Justice Matters meeting, which will focus on disproportionality.

## 2 Crime Trends

The Deputy Mayor and the Deputy Commissioner discussed the latest Office for National Statistics quarterly crime figures for England and Wales, reviewing the changes in crime in London and its comparison to the rest of England and Wales.

There was a discussion of what may be driving some of the increases, particularly in robbery and theft, where the increase in London has been larger than the increase in the rest of England and Wales.

## 3 Community Resolution

The Met's use of Community Resolution as an information police out-of court-disposal was discussed, following the Met's rolling it out, following the conclusion of a long-running pilot in eight London boroughs.

#### 4 Knife Crime and Stop and Search

The Deputy Mayor and the Deputy Commissioner discussed the use of stop and search in respect of reducing knife crime.

#### 5 Water Cannon

There was a discussion of the next steps for disposing of the water cannon.

The Deputy Commissioner provided an update on the review of cases following the recent issues that have been highlighted with disclosure in a number of recent trials.
