1 Budget

The Deputy Mayor and Commissioner discussed the implications of the budget for 2018/19 including maintaining officer strength and the impact on reserves. There was a discussion of how the Met would be investing the additional £15m funding from City Hall to target knife crime and other violent crime, including the establishment of the new violent crime taskforce, plus a discussion of how the Met will invest the additional funding provided for focussing on mental health.

2 Met Patrol Plus

There was a discussion of the Met Patrol Plus scheme.

3 Dedicated Ward Officers

The Deputy Mayor and Commissioner discussed the Dedicated Ward Officers (DWO), now rolled out with two DWOs per ward.

4 Supreme Court Ruling on Articles 3 and 8 of the European Court of Human Rights

There was a discussion of the Supreme Court's ruling on Articles 3 and 8 of the European Court of Human Rights in respect of the Worboys case and the Met's understanding of the impact of the ruling on investigative processes and training.
