1 **Violence Against Women and Girls**

There was a discussion of the Met's work addressing violence against women and girls, with a particular focus on domestic abuse and homicides, the implementation of the recommendations from Dame Elish Angiolini's report on investigation and prosecution of rape in London, and the concept of a domestic abuse register.

2 **National Police Air Service**

The Commissioner briefed the Deputy Mayor on the current model for the centralised provision of air support to all the forces in England and Wales and its operation in I ondon.

3 **Emergency Services Network**

The Commissioner updated the Deputy Mayor on the recent discussion at the Chief Constables Council meeting on the Home Office's programme for replacing Airwave with an Emergency Services Network.

4 **HMICFRS** Custody Inspection

There was a discussion of the recently published report of the HM Inspectorate of Prisons and HM Inspectorate of Constabulary and Fire & Rescue Services into the Met's custody suits.
