(DECEMBER 2017)**

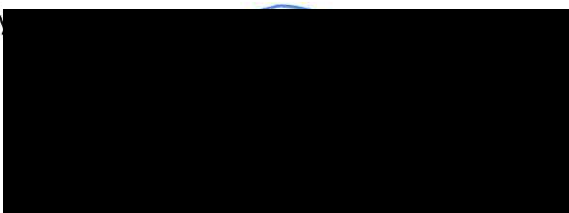
Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the emerging London Plan. You will also be aware of the joint response to the consultation by the Leaders of Kent and Medway authorities, to which Canterbury City Council is a signatory.

Canterbury City Council would like to offer its support for your emerging proposals to accommodate the vast majority of London's future growth within the Capital. We understand that the draft Plan does not include any proposal for additional housing provision in the Canterbury District and on this basis the Council has nothing further to add on these matters at this stage.

As a more general point, as the London Plan develops, we would expect to see any gap between housing needs and supply provided for within London. Where additional housing is necessary, it should be provided immediately adjacent to the Growth Corridors that have been identified in the Plan and should be supported by strategic infrastructure improvements. The strategy and mechanism by which this would be delivered should be set out clearly within the Plan.
