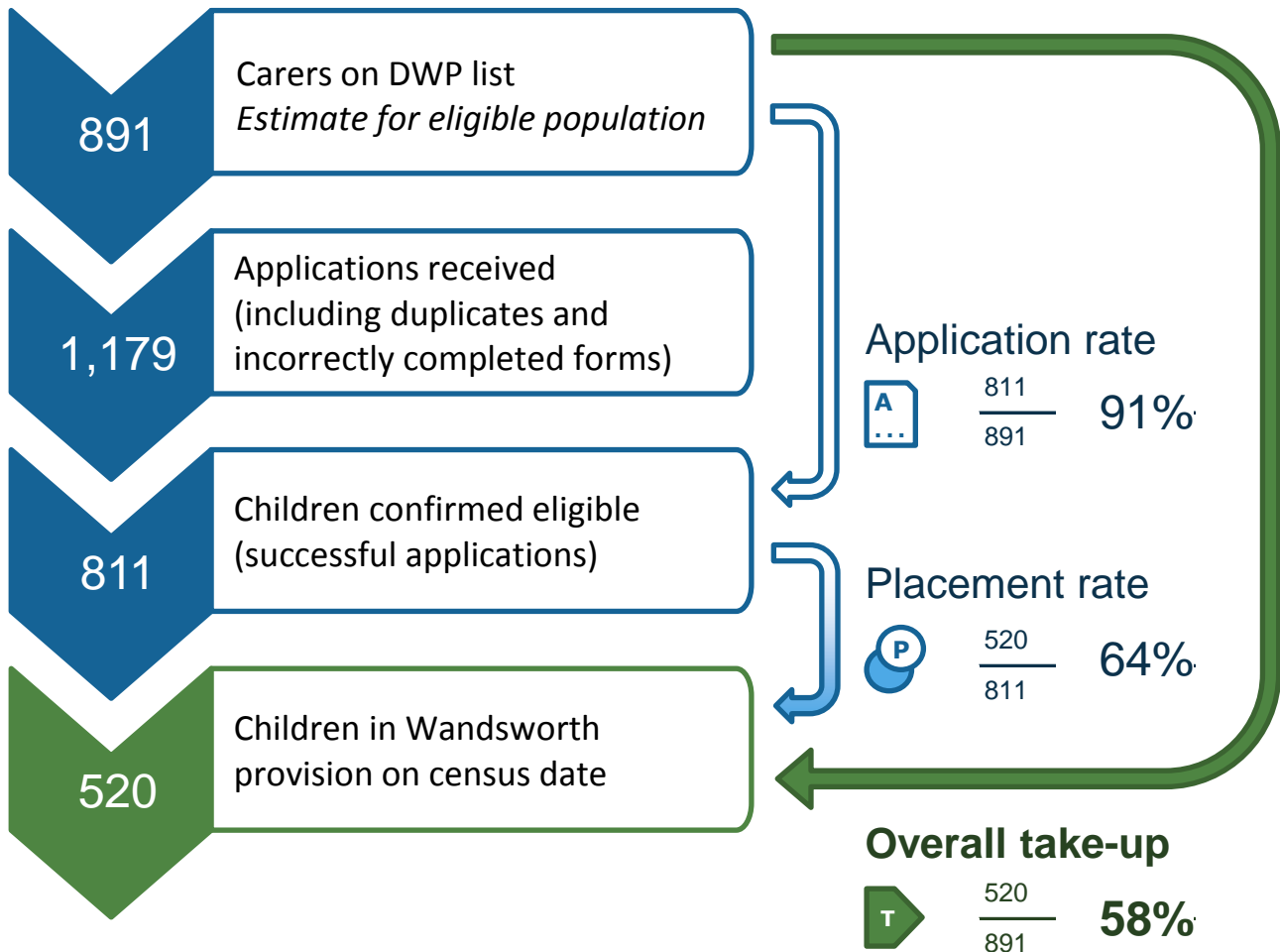


# Two-year-old take-up

## Wandsworth termly statistics

# Autumn 2019



### Internal (Wandsworth-only) rates term-by-term

|                  | Autumn 2018 | Spring 2019 | Summer 2019 | <b>Autumn 2019</b> |
|------------------|-------------|-------------|-------------|--------------------|
| Application rate | 85%         | 85%         | 82%         | <b>91%</b>         |
| Placement rate   | 66%         | 64%         | 64%         | <b>64%</b>         |
| Overall take-up  | 56%         | 54%         | 52%         | <b>58%</b>         |

These "internal" calculations do not include Wandsworth-resident children who attend provision outside the borough, children resident outside Wandsworth, or two-year-old pupils not claiming the entitlement. Therefore, internal figures for Overall Take-up will be lower than published annual figures produced by DfE.

### Published overall take-up rate from DfE (including out-borough placements)

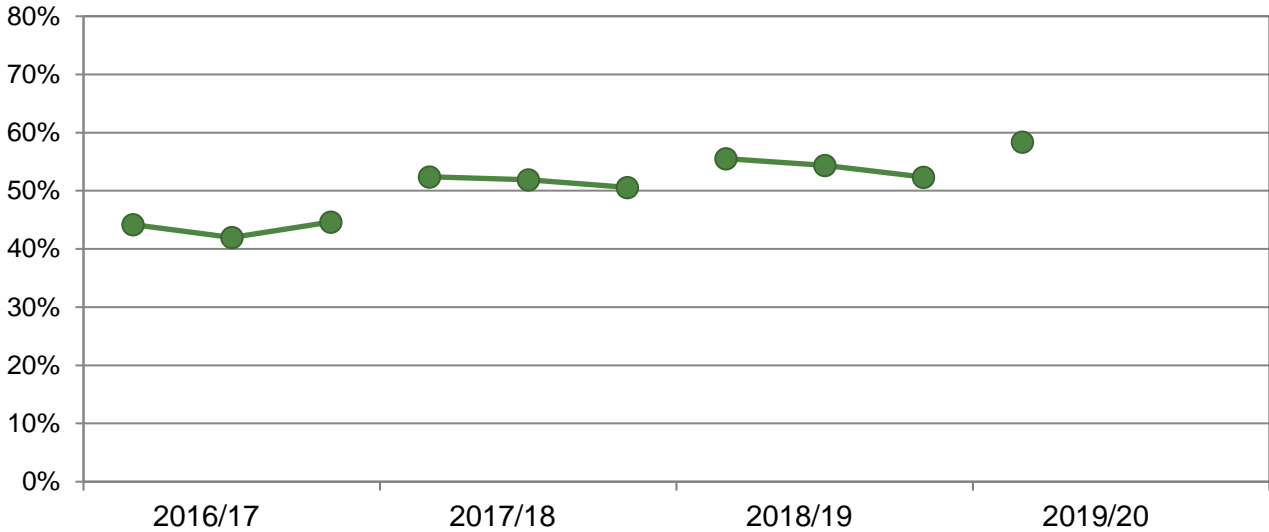



| Early Help Cluster | Estimated population |  Application rate |  Placement rate |  Overall take-up |
|--------------------|----------------------|--|--|---|
| Battersea          | 258                  |  93%              |  69%            |  64%             |
| Roehampton         | 340                  |  88%              |  62%            |  54%             |
| Tooting            | 293                  |  94%              |  62%            |  58%             |
