## High Court Judgment on Streetspace for London programme

I am writing to you to ask for further information following the High Court's recent judgment on TfL's Streetspace for London programme.<sup>1</sup>

The judgment has potentially significant implications for the status of current and future Streetspace schemes in London. The Committee is naturally interested in the Streetspace for London programme given the impact of individual schemes in local areas and the wider impact on the capital's transport network.

Therefore, I write to ask the following questions:

- 1. What immediate steps is TfL taking in response to the judgment?
- 2. When will TfL seek to appeal the judgment?
- 3. What impact does the judgment have on the status of existing Streetspace schemes in London?
- 4. What impact does the judgment have on the development of Streetspace schemes that are planned to be implemented in the next three months?
