


Expand your teaching - NCCE



- ➤ Link to **Gatsby Benchmarks** eg. #5 (Encounters with employers and employees)







How do I request a STEM Ambassador?

- Register as a teacher on the Stem Learning Platform: www.stem.org.uk
- 2. Browse the **Offers**
- 3. Add an activity and request Ambassadors to support
- 4. Once Ambassadors register interest, **discuss** your ideas with them
- 5. Choose whether to accept them onto your session
