

Community Fibre - London's Largest Fibre Only Network

- Bringing better Broadband to those that can benefit from it the most
- Backed by large infrastructure investors: Warburg Pincus, DTCP, RPMI and Amber Infrastructure
- Wayleaves with landlords representing over 500,000 properties
- Master wayleaves with 12 London Local Authorities with 5 more expected in the next few weeks
- Over £100m invested in London properties so far
- Target to enable 1m properties with full fibre connections by end of 2023
- Over 150 Community Spaces enabled with free Gigabit Internet connections
- 250 new jobs created across London






How is our fibre technology different?

Community Fibre's Installation


Data growth means homes need a true Fibre to the Home (FTTH) solution, but not all fibre is equal

• Our XGS-PON network currently delivers a 10Gb connections as standard, and is easily upgraded




Building Good Partnerships










97% of properties full fibre enabled within two years.

How san we reduce this to just one year with new boroughs?






Process of signing individual wayleaves for each estate can take a long time - even when using an agreed template.

Signing a Master wayleave at the end of last year has enabled us to speed up the build in 2020.






Good partnership with the M&E team meant that we were able to get our designs signed off quickly.

We have successfully worked with this borough to start to enable their SDU stock taking us beyond 100% of their MDU stock






Council was keen to get going, however it took a while to engage the right people at the ALMO.

Looking to bring in some independent third party surveying resource in the new year (paid for by Community Fibre) to help accelerate roll-out.





First plateau digital project manager was allocated to a different project and so rollout stopped.

Second plateau was one the project manager found a new job at a different organisation and so rollout stopped whilst a new project manager was recruited by the council.



Common Questions



Are you allowed not to do it?

do this?

Publish the wayleave that your organisation is prepared to use?

The City of London Corporation have published a standard template that all can use.

Building a new brand from scratch takes time.

We only market our service to the areas we can serve to avoid disappointment.



Is my building safe?

Check that the operator has proper quality management accreditation (eg ISO:9001)

Check they use an independent 3rd party fire assessor to check their works.

Review the RAMS documentation supplied



How can I properly resource the project?

The operator does most of the work and takes liability.

Maybe a project manager to guide internal stakeholders and someone from M&E / Housing to review the RAMS

Community Fibre can supply and pay for specialists if you do not have them



Will you engage residents properly?

We will write to all residents a number of times both before installation works start and whilst they are underway.

Where possible we meet with the RA to answer any questions they have.

Upset residents won't be interested in buying our services.



Free Gigabit connections to the Community Spaces our network passes.

Digital Ambassador programme that trains local people to become the ambassador for their own community.


