## Multiply reconciliation arrangements 2022-23 academic year

## Introduction

- 1. This guidance note for providers sets out the Multiply programme reconciliation arrangements for the 2022-23 academic year from August 2022 to July 2023.
- 2. Multiply funding is allocated to providers as a grant for the funding year 2022 to 2023. The GLA makes payments on a standard profile. The grant agreement states the maximum amount of Multiply provision which a provider can deliver between 1 August 2022 and 31 July 2023. The agreement also sets out the amount of grant funding available to you for the financial year 2022-23 (August to March) and financial year 2023-24 (April to July).

## Reconciliation

- 3. The following arrangements for reconciliation will apply for Multiply delivery in the academic year 2022-23:
  - Each provider must return a Quarter 4 Performance Report and an End of Financial Year Claim for the period of delivery up to 31 March 2023.
    Providers are required to submit both reports on GLA-OPS on or before 21 April 2023.
  - The GLA will review overall performance and discuss progress with providers. Providers should continue to deliver against the funding year grant profile up to 31 July 2023 to ensure a continuity of delivery.
  - At the end of the academic year, each provider must return a Funding Year Claim setting out their statement of grant usage, to evidence legitimate spend of the grant for the period 1 August 2022 to 31 July 2023. This return must include a statement of delivery against intervention targets for period 1 April 2023 to 31 July 2023. Providers are required to submit the report via GLA-OPS on or before **14 September 2023**.
  - Following this return in September, the GLA will reconcile funding for the Funding Year period 1 August 2022 to 31 July 2023. The GLA will review performance compared to allocation for the funding year from August to July.
  - Where funds are unspent against the funding year allocation, this amount will be recovered from each provider and an adjustment may be applied to the 2023-24 funding year or financial year grant allocations.
  - Please note that the above return dates may change subject to national requirements.
