The Local Plan will now be subjected to an independent examination to be conducted by the Planning Inspectorate. This is a continuous process running from the date of submission through to the receipt of the appointed Planning Inspector's Report. Part of this process will involve hearing sessions where those invited by the appointed Planning Inspector will have the opportunity to respond to matters raised. Once confirmed, all details relating to the examination process will be advertised on the website, made available online and sent to all respondents.
