

## GLA Funded Housing Starts on Site and Completions - London

To end of January 2016

### Notes

The figures in this report relate to programmes managed by the GLA plus additional units from schemes funded by boroughs outside London where the homes are located in London. The figures exclude additional completions reported from programmes managed directly by boroughs or DCLG, These completions are reported in the DCLG Live Tables on Affordable Housing at the following link:

<sup>1</sup> Information in the following tables is reported from the GLA's Investment Management System (IMS) or Project Control System (PCS)

<sup>2</sup> The National Affordable Housing Programme figures include Mortgage Rescue for 2009/10 and 2010/11.

<sup>3</sup> Open market units are homes developed for the private/open market and delivered on mixed use development sites funded through Kickstart (Investment Support) or Land and Property Programmes. The Open Market units delivered through these programmes include some starts and completions which are made available at below market price or rents but do not meet the definition for affordable housing.

<sup>4</sup> FirstBuy is a shared equity product for which starts on site are not reported.

<sup>5</sup> The National Affordable Housing Programme ended in March 2011 and outputs reported from 2011/12 onwards reflect commitments entered into prior to the closure date.

<sup>6</sup> The Affordable Homes Programme, a key part of which is the Affordable Rent product, replaced the National Affordable Housing Programme. Announcements on allocations under the new programme (AHP) were made in July 2011.

<sup>7</sup> The Mayors Housing Covenant (MHC) programme was launched in September 2012 to widen the affordable home ownership offer available to working Londoners.

<sup>8</sup> The GLA delegates the management of selected programmes to the HCA. Outturn from these programmes are reported here at the programme level only.

### Additional Programmes

In addition to the completions recorded through IMS and PCS there were 703 units/bed spaces completed through the Places of Change programme managed by the HCA. The Places of Change programme funded a range of projects with a specific focus on developing new ways of working with homeless people, some of these projects involved building new workspace or training areas to existing hostels. Only projects which involved the provision of new or upgrading of existing unsuitable accommodation are included in these numbers. The annual profile was 72 2009/10; 399 2010/11; 191 2011/12; 41 2012/13

### Revisions (Rev)

#### November 2013

The November 2013 release of housing statistics includes adjustments to the Land and Property and Affordable Housing programme affordable and open market housing completions and starts following a review of the sub programmes to include under London housing delivery. The resultant changes show a reduction of 39 affordable starts (revisions in 9/10 and 10/11), a reduction of 317 open market starts (revisions in 9/10 and 10/11), a reduction of 20 affordable completions (revisions in 9/10, 10/11 and 11/12) and an increase of 114 open market completions (revisions in 9/10, 10/11 and 12/13).

A further adjustment was made to the affordable housing starts in 2011/12, increasing by 81 units to reflect a review of outturn from two schemes made in that year.

#### October 2014

The October release of housing statistics includes an adjustment to the 2013-14 completions. 12 completions via the Traveller's Pitch programme are now reported via social rent not affordable rent.

#### November 2014

The November release of housing statistics exclude 87 completions reported via delegated programmes.
