

Park Royal Industrial Area Business Plan Prize Draw Survey

The final page of this survey asks you to click the 'I Agree' icon to indicate your acceptance of these terms and conditions. OPDC shall not be responsible for late, lost or delayed entries or network, computer hardware or software failures of any kind that may delay or restrict entry into the prize draw. Any entry made in any other format or which is incomplete illegible, defaced or a copy of an official form will be rejected.
